### 1. Revised Timetable for the Contest (Preliminaries)

• Revised Timetable for the Contest (Preliminaries) has been posted on contest website (<a href="http://contest.rceshk.com">http://contest.rceshk.com</a>). Teacher-in-charge and students can login to the system to view and download the contest time slot and venue.

#### 2. Admission ticket and procedure

- All contestants are required to arrive at the contest venue 15 minutes prior to the reporting time. Contestants <u>MUST</u> present admission ticket (printed copy with QR code) and identification documents; otherwise he/she will <u>NOT</u> be allowed to participate the contest.
- Admission ticket will contain information about particulars of contestants (Student ID, Name, School, Class and Class No.) and details of participation:
  - Application No.
  - Item
  - Date of contest
  - Venue of contest
  - Address
  - Reporting Time

correct.

The admission tickets can be downloaded after login. Please print out the admission

tickets after downloading, and distribute to students.

**Assessment Report and Certificate of Attendance** 

In general, assessment report and certificate of attendance will be distributed on

contest day.

• After finishing all sessions of the contest, contestant can collect the assessment

report and certificate at designated distribution point.

• If the contestant fails to collect them on the spot, the report and the certificate can be

collected by either a) pick-up in person or b) pick-up by school at a specific time.

4. Merit Award

• Contestants in Chinese items who score Level 5\* or above in preliminaries will

receive the Merit Award. Merit Award winners will be the finalists and each will be

awarded a certificate.

Contestants in English items who score straight Level 5 (Level 5 or above in all

Assessment Criteria) or above in preliminaries will receive the Merit Award. Merit

Award winners will be the finalists and each will be awarded a certificate.

with the Timetable of Contest (Final) on contest website.
