1. Revised Timetable for the Contest (Preliminaries)

Contestants in Chinese items who score Level 5* or above in preliminaries will

receive the Merit Award. Merit Award winners will be the finalists and each will be

awarded a certificate.

Contestants in English items who score straight Level 5 (Level 5 or above in all

Assessment Criteria) or above in preliminaries will receive the Merit Award. Merit

Award winners will be the finalists and each will be awarded a certificate.
